4. Why is Jesus so important? (John 3:16-18; 6:40; 14:6, 7)

Note: The only way to Heaven and the only way to real joy and peace and happiness in life is through Jesus. He wants you to know Him much better than you do now because He wants you to know how much He loves you and wants to be your special friend.
